The General Data Protection Regulation EU2016/679 (GDPR) and Data Protection Act 2018 gives us responsibilities in the way we handle personal information.

WSA processes large volumes of personal data in relation to its applicants and staff.

To comply with the law, information must be collected and used fairly, stored safely and not disclosed to any other person unlawfully.

Any action carried out which relates to personal information is known as processing. WSA is the Data Controller for the personal information it processes. We process this information for a variety of reasons in order to carry out our academic, employer and other administrative functions and to meet our legal obligations to funding bodies and government.

The Data Protection Policy sets out how personal data will be managed by WSA and explains responsibilities.

One of the most common ways in which people exercise their data protection rights is to request a copy of the information an organisation holds about them.
